

KICKBOXING RULES

- 1. Fights of 3 Rounds of 2 Minutes, with 1 Minute breaks.
- 2. Hooking and holding prohibited (2 warnings only).
- 3. No grabbing on the ropes while kicking.
- 4. When a knockout occurs, the referee will designate a neutral corner.
- 5. No spinning back fist. This is an illegal technique.
- 6. 3 knockouts and/or 3 counts of 8 in the same round, or a total of 4 counts during the fight will be disqualified.
- 7. Required equipment:
 - Safety kicks
 - Shin pads that cover the foot
 - Jockstrap
 - Mouth guard
- 8. Only soft contact lenses are permitted. Ponytails must be tucked inside the head gear.
- 9. No jewelry and/or body piercings allowed during the fight. The medical bracelet is to be handed to the corner man.
- 10. Absolutely no tape allowed on the gloves.
- 11. No oily substance (i.e. Vaseline) allowed on helmets.
- 12. No electrical tape or masking tape allowed on fighting equipment.
- 13. A maximum of 3 corner men allowed. The corner men must be registered ISKA members. Only 1 corner man is allowed in the ring between rounds.

- 14. At the sound of the whistle, you have 10 seconds to leave the ring.
- 15. If a boxer is not wearing their mouth guard once the fight has begun, a penalty point will be given for delaying the fight.
- 16. Absolutely no hitting on the ring.
- 17. Abusive language is not permitted. The use of such language will result in a penalty or disqualification.
- 18. It is prohibited to hang towels and/or water containers on the ring.
- 19. During the round, corner men must remain seated at all times (only 1 warning will be given).
- 20. Verify the order of your fighter and ensure he is always ready in case of a quick victory of the preceding fight.
- 21. Start the fight with a traditional bow to the referee and the fighters.
- 22. Sportsmanship is required before, during and after the fight.
